An examination fee of \$35 (check, money order or credit card) is required and must be submitted with the application. The \$35 fee will be waived for those who are receiving General Assistance, Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) or Supplemental Security Income (S.S.I.).

REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicants must be citizens of the United States as of March 31, 2010.
2. Applicants must meet residency preferences specified on page 6 as of March 31, 2010.
3. Applicants must be high school or vocational high school graduates, or possess an approved high school equivalent certificate by March 31, 2010.
4. Applicants must be at least 18 but not over 35 (one is over 35 on the day after his or her 35th birthday) except that volunteer firefighters must not be over 40 as of March 31, 2010. See page 7 for exceptions.
5. Candidates certified from the eligible list may be required to undergo a medical and psychiatric examination administered by the hiring agency.
6. Appointees will be required to possess a driver's license valid in New Jersey.
7. For some jurisdictions, once appointed, employees may be required to successfully complete an approved Emergency Medical Technician program and maintain certification while employed as a Firefighter. Please contact the jurisdiction of interest to determine if you will be required to obtain the EMT certification after you are hired.
8. CPR Certification: Appointees may be required to possess a current and valid CPR Certification issued by the American Red Cross or the American Heart Association.
9. Candidates must be residents of New Jersey as of the last date for filing applications (March 31, 2010) and as of their appointment date to a Firefighter position.
10. Candidates interested in Bilingual Spanish and English positions will be tested at the time of certification for their bilingual proficiency in reading, writing, speaking and communicating effectively in Spanish.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE FIREFIGHTER APPLICATION FORM

(READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE COMPLETING YOUR APPLICATION)

FEE: A **\$35.00** fee is required to file your application. Make a check or money order payable to NJCSC, or pay by credit card. **Do not send cash and do not staple or pin the check to the application. Use paper clips or simply enclose payment.**

1. FEE EXEMPTION: If you currently receive General Assistance (welfare), Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (T.A.N.F. previously AFDC), or Supplemental Security Income (SSI), you are exempt from submitting the fee. Indicate the type of assistance you are receiving and enclose the required proof. Send only copies of documents with your application. No materials will be returned.

2. PAYMENT METHOD: Check one box to indicate your method of payment. If payment is by credit card, provide the required credit card information and sign in the space provided. **NOTE: Debit Cards are not accepted.**

3. BILINGUAL ABILITY: Check the bilingual box if you are interested in a Bilingual Spanish and English position. Candidates will be tested at the time of certification for the ability to effectively read, write, speak and communicate in Spanish.

4. LAST NAME: **5. FIRST NAME:** and **6. M.I.:** Clearly print in capital (UPPERCASE) letters your last name, first name, and middle initial.

7. SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER: Your Social Security number will be kept confidential and used to track and correctly identify all of your records and transactions associated with the application and testing process. Collecting this data is permissible under NJSA 11A:6-2.5 and NJAC 4A:6-4.2(e) but its submission is voluntary. If you do not provide the number, a unique number will be assigned to you. However, once assigned, you will be responsible for remembering it for any inquiries you may have concerning your application or testing process.

8. RESIDENCY CODE: Enter your 4-digit New Jersey residency code from the list of codes on pages 4 & 5 of this announcement. First, find the county, and then the specific municipality in which you reside. Copy the corresponding code into the boxes. This might not be the same as your mailing address. **Important: Failure to complete this code properly will cause you to be rejected for this examination. Please re-check your code for accuracy. If you live outside New Jersey,** you are not eligible to file for this announcement.

9. DAYTIME TELEPHONE NUMBER: Enter a telephone number where you can be reached from 9 am to 5 pm.

10. CITIZEN: Check the appropriate block. If you are not a United States citizen, you cannot file for this examination.

11. MAILING ADDRESS: Clearly print your complete mailing address in capital (UPPERCASE) letters.

12. VETERANS' PREFERENCE: Check the box if you are claiming veterans' preference for this examination. If you have established veterans' preference since April 1, 1980, no further action is needed. Otherwise, complete a veterans' preference claim form and include the required documents with it. **The completed claim form must be submitted to the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs (DMAVA), and postmarked by the last date for filing applications on March 31, 2010 in order to establish New Jersey veterans' preference for this exam.** Claim forms are available at our offices at 44 So. Clinton Ave., Trenton, NJ, or on our web site at www.state.nj.us/csc. DMAVA is responsible for determining eligibility for Civil Service Veterans' Preference. You may visit their web site at www.state.nj.us/military or contact them at 1-888-865-8387 for more information.

13. ADA ASSISTANCE: If you believe you qualify for an accommodation based on the Americans with Disabilities Act and would like to be contacted regarding an auxiliary aid or accommodation, check this box. You will be contacted prior to the test and asked to provide documentation that supports your request for an aid or accommodation.

14. VOLUNTEER STATUS: (If you are not a volunteer Firefighter, skip to number 15 below.) Check the box to indicate if you are now serving as a volunteer Firefighter. Print the name of the municipality where you volunteer. Enter the date you became a volunteer in this municipality. If applicable, enter the number of the jurisdiction where you are a volunteer (see page 6). Enter the 4-digit residency code from the list of Residency Codes on pages 4 & 5 to indicate the municipality where you are a volunteer. First, find the county, and then the specific town, borough, city, or township where you volunteer. Copy the corresponding code into these boxes.

15. TEST LOCATION PREFERENCES: Check one box to indicate the county where you prefer to take the examination. **Note:** If you fail to make a selection, you may be automatically scheduled for a Mercer County test location. You will not be able to change your test center once you are scheduled.

16. BACKGROUND DATA: Check the box to indicate the group of which you are a member; indicate your gender; enter your date of birth using a 4-digit year; and indicate the highest level of diploma or degree you have earned. **NOTE:** Completion of date of birth and education is mandatory. Do not send a transcript or resume with this form.

17. SIGNATURE: Sign and date the application after carefully reading the certification statement. Use a 4-digit year in the date.

FILING INSTRUCTIONS

Mail your completed application and fee (or proof of fee exemption, if eligible) to NJ CSC Firefighter Exam M9999M, P.O. Box 785, South Amboy, NJ 08879-0785. Be sure to keep a copy for your records. Your application **must be postmarked on or before March 31, 2010.** Be sure your application is complete before it is submitted.

NOTE: If eligible, send only copies (no originals) of FEE EXEMPTION documentation with your application. Do not send any other documentation with your application. Materials submitted will not be returned.

Merit System Jurisdictions With Full-Time Paid Firefighter Positions

Candidates should file only one application. The Civil Service Commission will automatically place candidates who pass the examination on the eligible list(s) based on residency and volunteer preference, if applicable. See below for examples.

Example #1 - You are a resident of Woodbridge Township. You will be placed on the lists for all three Woodbridge Township Fire Districts. If you are a volunteer in FD #3 and complete block #14 on the exam application, you will be awarded service credit points only in Fire District #3 if you are eligible for the points. If you are not a volunteer you will still be placed on the eligible lists for all three Fire Districts, but you will not be awarded any service credit points. You will also be placed on the list for Burlington City since the residency preference is open to the State.

Example #2 – You are a resident of Newark. You will be placed on the Newark eligible list. You will be placed on the list for Clifton, Belleville, Bloomfield, Harrison, Kearny and Millburn because the residency preferences for those jurisdictions are open to Essex County where Newark is located.

When completing block #14 of your application regarding your volunteer service in a Fire District, use the Fire District number listed below to complete the Fire District Number boxes for which you serve as a volunteer. Use 2 digits such as 01 for FD #01, or 02 for FD #02. If you are a volunteer in a municipal fire department you must complete the volunteer section (block #14), but leave the Fire District Number boxes blank.

If you are not a volunteer Firefighter in a Fire District or municipal fire department leave block 14 blank.

Volunteer Firefighter Service Credit

The Appellate Division of the New Jersey Superior Court made a determination on December 19, 2002, that interprets the preference provided to volunteer Firefighters in merit system jurisdictions by State Law N.J.S.A. 40A:14-45. The law provides that volunteers with at least two years of continuous volunteer service are eligible for anything from 3 to 10 service credits (points) which shall be added to their passing score on the exam. Please note this service must immediately precede the closing date.

The service credit points are calculated by adding one point to the years of service. For example, three points are added for two years of service, four points are added for three years of service and so on up to 10 points maximum. Any service time in excess of nine years shall be awarded the 10 point maximum. The service credit is calculated as of the last date for filing applications for the examination announcement. Because there is no absolute volunteer Firefighter preference, there will no longer be separate volunteer eligible lists and municipal eligible lists. There will be one list for each jurisdiction which will include both volunteers and non-volunteers.

NOTE: VOLUNTEERS - In order to be awarded service credit points you must complete block # 14 on the application for the fire district or part-paid municipal fire department where you currently volunteer.

Children of Firefighters Killed in Action

Recently enacted law N.J.S.A. 40A:14-10.1a grants hiring preference to children of firefighters killed in action. The law gives them preference over non-veterans, but not over veterans. You will be required to provide documentation if you check this box.

Maximum Hiring Age Requirement

Non-volunteer candidates over age 35 (one is considered to be over 35 on the day after his or her 35th birthday) as of the last date for filing applications for this examination announcement are not eligible for appointment to a Firefighter position. A non-volunteer candidate who turns age 35 while on an eligible list remains eligible for appointment to a Firefighter position for the life of the eligible list.

However, there are two exceptions to the above.

Exception 1 - Volunteer Firefighters who are over age 35, but not over age 40, are eligible for appointment to a Firefighter position. Once a volunteer turns over age 40 he/she cannot be appointed to a Firefighter position even if the eligible list he/she is on has not expired.

Exception 2 – Non-volunteer and volunteer Firefighter candidates may reduce their actual age by the amount of their military service during the periods, and under the conditions, specified in the Civil Service Act related to New Jersey veterans' preference in order to meet the maximum hiring age requirement. Military service that does not fall within the periods and under the conditions specified in the Act cannot be deducted from one's actual age. The military service deduction is made as of the last date for filing applications for the examination. See page 8 for the periods and conditions for veterans' preference.

Residence Preference

Hiring jurisdictions may classify eligible candidates into the following tiers based on the candidates' legal residence: 1) Residents of the municipality; 2) Residents of the county in which the municipality is located; 3) Residents in the State; and 4) All other qualified candidates. Appointments shall be made in the order of their tiers; each tier must be exhausted before the next tier can be used.

Each candidate's residency is established as of the closing date of the announcement and cannot be changed after that date. In addition, in some jurisdictions the candidates must maintain continuous residency to the appointment date. Because the residency cannot be changed after the closing date candidates should be aware that if they change their residence after the closing date, they may not be eligible for appointment because they failed to maintain continuous residency in a jurisdiction that requires it.

IMPORTANT: Here's an example of the problem that could occur by changing one's residence after the last date for filing an application:

Ewing and Trenton both have the hiring preference for their municipal residents. They also both require that applicants be municipal residents at the time of their appointment (continuous residency). Assume that the last date for filing an application is March 31, 2010 and that John files an application on that date indicating residency code 1102 for Ewing. On June 30, 2010 John notifies the Civil Service Commission (CSC) that he moved to the City of Trenton. CSC will change his address for mailing purposes only, but does not change the residency code because it reflects where the applicant resided as of the last day for filing applications. Later, John's name is certified from a Ewing list because of his original Ewing residence code. However, Ewing will disqualify him because he no longer lives there. Even if he moves back to Ewing, he failed to maintain continuous residency in Ewing and, therefore, cannot be appointed. Similarly, John cannot be certified to Trenton because he did not live in Trenton as of March 31, 2010, the last date for filing an application.

CIVIL SERVICE VETERAN'S PREFERENCE

To be eligible for veteran's preference/status under New Jersey Law, one must have served on active duty during one of the following periods or incurred a service-connected injury irrespective of length of service:

1. **World War II:** 90 days active duty on or after September 16, 1940 and must have begun on or before December 31, 1946.
2. **Korean Conflict:** 90 days active duty on or after June 23, 1950 and must have begun on or before January 31, 1955.
- *3. **Lebanon Crisis:** 14 days on or after July 1, 1958, commencing on or before November 1, 1958.
4. **Vietnam Conflict:** 90 days active duty on or after December 31, 1960 and must have begun on or before May 7, 1975.
- * 5. **Lebanon:** 14 days on or after September 26, 1982 and must have begun on or before December 1, 1987.
- * 6. **Grenada:** 14 days on or after October 23, 1983 and must have begun on or before November 21, 1983.
- * 7. **Panama:** 14 days on or after December 20, 1989 and must have begun on or before January 31, 1990.
- * 8. **Operation Desert Shield/Desert Storm:** 14 days on or after August 2, 1990 to February 28, 1991.
- * 9. **Somalia:** 14 days on or after December 5, 1992 and must have begun on or before March 31, 1994.
- * 10. **Bosnia and Herzegovina (Operation Joint Endeavor/Operation Joint Guard):** 14 days on or after November 20, 1995 and on or before June 20, 1998.
- * 11. **Haiti (Operation Uphold Democracy):** 14 days on or after September 19, 1994 and on or before March 31, 1995.
- * 12. **Operation Enduring Freedom:** 14 days on or after September 11, 2001.
- * 13. **Operation Iraqi Freedom:** 14 days on or after March 19, 2003.
14. **Operations Southern and Northern Watch:** 14 days on or after August 27, 1992

***NOTE:** To be eligible for preference for the above peacekeeping missions, one must have served in Lebanon, Grenada, Panama, the Persian Gulf, Bosnia, Herzegovina, Haiti, Operation Enduring Freedom, or Operation Iraqi Freedom, or on board any ship actively engaged in patrolling the territorial waters of that nation for a period of at least 14 days beginning on or before the date of termination of that mission or operation.

To be eligible for disabled veteran's preference, one must be a "veteran" as described above (except that such person receiving an actual service-incurred disability need not fulfill the 90/14 day requirement) and must have incurred a disability for which the veteran is eligible for or receiving ten percent or greater disability compensation. Spouses of disabled veterans, surviving spouses of disabled veterans or veterans and parents of veterans who died in service are eligible for preference, if the veteran would have been eligible for veteran's preference.

NOTE: Individuals whose only active service was for training in connection with a Reserve or National Guard obligation are not eligible for Veteran's Preference.

NOTE: Merchant Marine Personnel who served in World War II, and who present a DD-214 which establishes 90 days of active service during the period noted above, are entitled to Veteran's Preference.
