To be a Newark firefighter, you must first qualify and then pass all written and physical examinations.

## To Qualify

You must:

- Be a United States citizen
- Be a Newark resident
- Be between the ages of 18 - 35
- Possess a high school diploma/GED
- Possess a valid New Jersey driver's license

## The Examinations\*:

Applicants must pass a:

- Written exam
- Physical exam to test endurance, skills and ability to overcome difficult situations

\* Failure to meet the established minimum score on any component will result in a failing grade.

Successful appointees will then attend the Fire Academy and serve a one-year probationary period.

## APPLICATION INFO

The last date for filing applications is March 31, 2010.

An examination fee of \$35 (check, money order or credit card) is required and must be submitted with the application. The \$35 fee will be waived for those who are receiving General Assistance, Temporary Assistance for Needy families (TANF) or Supplemental Security Income (SSI).
